POLICE ASK PUBLIC FOR INFORMATION REGARDING HOMICIDE



On April 15, 2009, the body of Shawn Hazel Turk, W/F, age 34, was found near the AmTrak Station, 600 E. Main Street, in Lakeland, Florida. The cause of death was determined to be a homicide. Police are asking anyone who saw Shawn between the dates of April 9, 2009, and April 15, 2009, to contact the Lakeland Police Department.

Shawn is described as 5'06" tall, weighing between 130 to 150 pounds, with auburn hair with reddish tints. Shawn was last seen wearing a black t-shirt with the words, "I didn't do it" on the back in white lettering. Shawn also had on light blue jeans and blue/white Nike tennis shoes. Shawn was believed to have been in the area between Lake Mirror and Memorial Blvd., including the area of the 24 hour store on Massachusetts Avenue, and the Grey Hound Bus Station.
