Lakeland Police Seek Public's Help to Identify Suspect in Car Jacking Attempt

Lakeland Police are investigating a car jacking attempt where the victim was shot by the suspect. The victim was in his vehicle on June 13, 2009, parked by the main entrance of 5251 Long Lake Circle when the suspect got into the passenger seat, pointed a gun at him, and told the victim to get out of the car. The suspect shot the victim when he refused to give the suspect his car.

Attached is a composite sketch of the suspect. The suspect is further described as a black male, 6'02" tall, slender build and an "ugly" face.
